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## 2021 - 2022 Season Scholarship Guidelines

Each year, through the support of generous individuals and fundraisers through the school, Judith Svalander School of Ballet is pleased to offer scholarship opportunities to students who wish to study at our school. Each scholarship award is determined by both the number of applicants and the amount of funds available.

## Recipients must review the guidelines set forth below:

- Scholarships do not include registration fees, performance fees, private lessons, or any expense outside the session tuition. Scholarships apply to session tuition only; awards are offered for the 2021-2022 academic season and not summer workshops.
- Scholarships are awarded on a year-to-year basis. In other words, even if you have received financial assistance in years past, you must be reconsidered annually.
- Recipients must fulfill any remaining tuition payment obligations.
- Recipients must have excellent attendance, with no unapproved absence. All approved absences must be made up during the same 12-week session.
- The yearly scholarship is largely based on artistic merit, financial needs, attendance, and dedication to the study of dance.
- Artistic merit is at the sole discretion of the Artistic Director, Assistant Artistic Director, and Instructors.
- Judith Svalander School of Ballet may reduce or withdraw awards at any point during the year for students missing classes or failing to meet expectations.
- Financial need may be determined based on the supporting documents requested of you. Proof of income in the form of your 2018 tax return (preferred) or a W-2. Both parent's forms are preferred. The school may request additional information from you to determine your need.
- Scholarship applicants agree to abide by all of the policies set forth by Judith Svalander School of Ballet as listed on the schools' official website.
- No exceptions will be made to any of the policies stated above.

Parents/Guardians of scholarship recipients are encouraged to volunteer to provide assistance to the school.
